

Unity Certified Instructor Program – FAQ

The Unity Certified Instructor (UCI) program recognizes leaders who have demonstrated excellence in both Unity skills and teaching proficiency. We have put together this resource to help you get started with the UCI authorization process.

Authorization Process

- Complete an application form and sign the UCI Agreement
- Pass a Unity Certification exam
- Pass the CompTIA CTT+ exam OR provide evidence of other recognized instructional skill certifications
- We recommend that you aim to complete the certification process within a 90-day period

Unity Certification

The first step to earn the Unity Certified Instructor status is to pass either the [Unity Certified 3D Artist](#) or the [Unity Certified Programmer](#) exam.

KnowledgePoint Connect will make several resources available to help you prepare for the exam including Unity's 30-day Learning Pathway and free access to [Unity Certification Courseware](#).

Unity Certification exams are delivered through Pearson VUE. Once you are ready to take the exam, you can do so in a test center or online from your home/office.

UCI candidates who are associated with a Unity Authorized Training Partner or a Unity Academic Alliance Member will receive a free of charge exam voucher.

Instructors who already have a valid Unity certification do not have to take a new exam to qualify as a UCI.

Instructional Skills

The CompTIA Certified Technical Trainer (CTT+) exam validates the knowledge and use of tools and techniques necessary for successfully delivering technical training.

We will provide a free of charge CompTIA CTT+ exam voucher to all UCI candidates who are associated with a Unity Authorized Training Partner or a Unity Academic Alliance Member.

Other recognized instructional skill certifications

- An endorsement letter from an academic institution (secondary & post-secondary)
- Valid instructor certifications from a Unity peer company including Adobe, Apple, Autodesk and Microsoft
- Training industry certifications including TPMA, New Horizons and many more
